iPad use in Class	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• iPads will be used in class and for homework assignments.• iPads will be used as a homework planner.• Please remember to charge your iPad at home.• iPads are to be used appropriately at all times.
Text Books	<p>This course has one science text book that will be left at home. Text book will be supplied to each student during the first week of school.</p>
Grading Policy	<p>Grading is based on a point system. $\frac{\text{points earned}}{\text{total points}} = \text{Grade}$</p> <p>Example: $\frac{300}{350} = 0.857 \times 100 = 86\%$</p>
Tests	<p>The primary testing day is Friday. Students will be notified of the testing day one week in advance of the test date. Students are responsible for coming to class prepared with their own pencil, pen, and eraser.</p>
Quizzes	<p>Quizzes will be given weekly, announced or unannounced. Students are responsible for coming to class prepared with their own pencil, pen, and eraser.</p>
Homework	<p>Every completed homework assignment that is checked is worth 5 points. Homework is to be completed in the homework section of your binder. Homework assignments will be checked at the beginning of each class and must have the proper heading on the page. All questions must be written out and all answers should be highlighted.</p>

Missing Homework	Late assignments may be turned in the following class for 3 points. Missing homework assignments later than 2 days may be turned in for 1 point.
